

Back to School Reading Zone Challenge



Terms and Conditions for Back to School Reading Zone Challenge

- a. These terms and conditions apply to the Back to School Reading Zone Challenge. The promoter is the National Literacy Trust. Chase is not a promoter of or responsible for the Back to School Reading Zone Challenge.
- b. The eligible age for entries to this challenge is students aged between 7 and 14 years (Key Stages 2 and 3, or P4 to S3). Entrants must have parent/guardian permission.
- c. The closing date for entries is 23.59 on 4 November 2022.
- d. Entries are to be submitted by an entrant's school as scans or photographs to competitions@literacytrust.org.uk.
- e. Eligible entries are photographs of A1 Reading Zone posters showing students' engagement with the challenge. Entries are submitted by a school on email.
- f. A winning entry will be chosen at random by National Literacy Trust staff and the winning school will be informed by 1 December 2022.
- g. The winning entry will receive a physical reading zone for their school courtesy of our partner Chase. The reading zone includes beanbag chairs and 30 age appropriate titles from the [wellbeing booklist](#) referenced with this challenge.
- h. The General terms and conditions for Reading Champions Challenges shall apply.

3. Entries must be submitted by a member of school staff supplying their full contact details and entry documentation/evidence as set out on the challenge webpage.

5. There will not be a notification of receipt for entries.
